<b>Wage subsidy for employers of Apprentices in Priority Occupations</b>	For employers of new or recommending Apprentices undertaking Certificate III or higher in a Priority Occupation, listed on the Priority list. To view the Priority List <a href="#">click here</a> .	10% of the wages paid for an eligible apprentice in their first and second year to a maximum of \$1,500 per quarter per apprentice <b>AND</b> 5% of wages paid for an eligible apprentice in their third year up to maximum of \$750 per quarter per apprentice.	Eligible employers of any size if they engage an Australian Apprentice between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2024.
<b>Wage Subsidy for employers of Apprentices in Priority Occupations located in regional/remote Australia</b>	For employers of new or recommending Apprentices undertaking Certificate III or higher in a Priority Occupation, listed on the Priority list, located in regional/remote Australia (as per ABS definition).	Additional 5% of wages paid for an eligible apprentice in their first year to a maximum of \$2,250 per quarter <b>AND</b> 10% of wages paid for an eligible apprentice in their second year up to a maximum of \$1,500 per quarter per apprentice <b>AND</b> 5% of wages paid for an eligible apprentice in their third year up to a maximum of \$750 per quarter per apprentice.	Eligible employers of any size if they engage an Australian Apprentice between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2024.

**Hiring Incentive  
for employers of

in a Priority  
Occupation**

For employers of new or recommencing Apprentices undertaking Certificate II or higher in a trade NOT on the Priority Occupation list. To view the Priority List [click here](#).

\$3,500 paid to the employer in two equal six-monthly installments following commencement.

Eligible employers of any size if they engage an Australian Apprentice between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2024.
