

Certificate III in Carpentry

Best if you're new to the industry

EARLY CAREER SCHOLARSHIP - \$2,200

This is available to you for if you would like to undertake a preapprenticeship, apprenticeship or further training in a construction or related field. To help you get prepared for the construction industry, the funds are split into two parts:

- \$1,200 towards approved course fees
- \$1,000 worth of quality tools relevant to your trade

Previous successful candidates have used these funds towards a variety of qualifications including:

- Certificate III in Carpentry
- Certificate II in Electrotechnology
- Certificate III in Cabinet Making
 - Certificate III in Plumbing
- Plant machinery training
- AutoCAD Level 1

Best if you're building on your skills

CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHOLARSHIP -UP TO \$5,000

This is available to you if you would like to pursue a qualification above Certificate III level or approved professional development in a construction or related field. Funds can be also be put towards reference materials or equipment to assist you with your selected training.

This scholarship can be used towards training in the following subcategories.

BUILDER REGISTRATION

Course options could include Certificate IV or Diploma level qualifications in Building and Construction or approved Builder Registration professional development programs.

INDUSTRY NEED

Course options could include qualifications in Building Surveying, Construction Management or other courses to develop skills and experience within the industry.

LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT

Course options could include diploma or degree courses in Design, Civil Engineering, Construction Management or Project Management or accredited courses and other qualifications to support you to progress a career in a leadership role.

SUSTAINABILITY AND INNOVATION

Course options could include advancing technological benefits in the fields of construction, design and trades. Sustainability courses include Passive House training, Master Builders Green Living (Domestic) short course or other qualifications designed to develop expertise in sustainability and energy efficient construction.

LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP - UP TO \$5,000

Funds can be sought to support course fees as well as reference materials, equipment or other expenses that are necessary to successfully complete your studies.

CORPORATE APPLICATIONS

Corporate applications are open to organisations which provide initiatives to support the building and construction industry. Support from the Foundation could include sponsorship of award categories at student award ceremonies, funding for projects aimed at strengthening the skills of the building and construction workforce and more. ELIGIBILITY & HOW TO APPLY FOR INDIVIDUAL APPLICANTS

To be eligible to apply, you must be either an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident of Australia.

Applicants must reside in Victoria upon their application date and intend to remain involved in the building and construction industry in Victoria following completion of their selected course or training. You must also be able to demonstrate that you receive limited support from other sources, such as parents, and identify the barrier that you are facing in accessing the studies, whether that is financial, occupational or some other barrier that the support of the Foundation could help unlock
