For the first time since 2019 the conference will be a live event again and at time of significant change. The release of the 2022 National Construction Code has seen several changes to the energy efficiency standards for new houses. For the first time since 2013 the minimum star rating has been increased from 6 to 7 Star. A whole of house rating has also been introduced.

People spending more time at home during the last 2 year's lockdowns increased their awareness of how cold their homes could get. Spending long periods studying or working from home meant heating and cooling systems were used for much longer periods than before resulting in increased energy bills. More than ever a well built, energy efficient home that is warm in winter, cool in summer and filled with daylight all year long is critically important. Demand for energy efficient housing has increased. Many companies are now offering houses that exceed minimum standards, are zero carbon or built to the passive house standard.

The Green Living Conference features industry experts who will explain what it takes to build and renovate for improved energy efficiency and comfort. "The link between energy efficiency and mould in buildings" We are all now moving on to making 7 Star residential buildings. Are the 7 Star external wall systems that different to 6 Star external wall systems? Why are cavities and air-tightness so important? What is this Mould Growth Index? This presentation will provide some insights regarding typical and contemporary external residential wall systems used in Victoria and what the design and construction professions should be considering to reduce adverse outcomes.
