THE AWARDS

The Master Builders Victoria Excellence in Housing Awards acknowledge and celebrate the outstanding achievements and high quality construction of members in the residential sector of the building industry.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- Open to current financial members of Master Builders Victoria who are involved in residential construction
- Projects must have been completed to practical completion within the period 12th April 2022 - Friday, 12th April 2024.
- Projects entered previously may not be resubmitted.
- Entries must be complete (see Entry Requirements for details) at the time of closing date; otherwise entry will not be accepted.
- Builders and clients must be present during the inspection by judges.
- If you have outstanding accounts relating to previous Master Builders Victoria Building Excellence Awards, you may not be eligible to submit entries in the current year's award program until payment is received.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

The closing date for entries is 11.59pm Friday, 12th April 2024. **Late entries will not be accepted.**

ENTRY FEE

FIRST ENTRY ONLY

\$700 (includes one complimentary ticket to the awards presentation evening)

ADDITIONAL ENTRIES

\$450 (does not include tickets to the awards presentation evening)

KITCHEN AND BATHROOM ENTRIES

\$110 per entry (does not include tickets to the Awards presentation evening)

AWARDS PRESENTATION EVENING

The Awards Presentation evening will be held on Friday, 11th October 2024. A special feature presentation will be made of each category winner. Invitations will be sent in August 2024.

JUDGING CRITERIA

All entries are judged by a panel of industry representatives according to the strict criteria. Entries will be assessed by the following criteria:

QUALITY OF CONSTRUCTION

- Internal (fixing, joinery, fixtures and fittings, finishing)
- External (structure, fixing, finishing)

CLIENT RELATIONSHIP

 Processes/systems for client comms (pre construction, during construction, post construction/handover)

DESIGN

 Builder designed/input by Builder

EXECUTION OF DESIGN

- Functional and serviceable
- Degree of difficulty in construction
- Street scape (integrated housing developments only)
- Infrastructure (integrated housing developments only)

VALUE FOR MONEY

- Current market trends
- Consistency throughout the project

SUSTAINABILITY/INNOVATION

- Sustainable features above 6 star
- Innovation/technology

JUDGING

Judging will take place between 3rd June and 5th July 2024. A judging panel will inspect all projects entered. It is also important that relevant personnel (i.e. Builder and client) attend the inspection and will be able to answer any questions posed by the judges.

Entrants will receive at least one week's notice of the inspection time and date. There is limited ability to reschedule allocated inspections. Ensure you have advised of your and your clients unavailable dates during the submission process. Whilst Master Builders Victoria cannot guarantee that we can accommodate your request, it will be taken into consideration at the time of scheduling. Please allow at least 45 minutes to 1 hour per site for inspection.

The judges' decision is final and binding. If, in the opinion of the judges, the entries do not reach the quality standard for the competition, the judges and Master Builders Victoria may decide not to grant an award in that category. The Judges may also reclassify any entry. Should this occur, the entrant will be notified in advance.

MEDIA COVERAGE

Media coverage of the Master Builders Victoria Excellence in Housing Awards includes (but is not limited to) the Master Builders Victoria Winning Homes magazine, Master Builders Victoria website and Master Builders Victoria magazine. Please be aware you may be contacted by the publishers of the Winning Homes magazine, News Corp, to discuss advertising opportunities for this publication. Editorial comment on and photographic display of the projects entered will be at the discretion of the appropriate media and Master Builders Victoria. Whilst it is the aim of Master Builders Victoria to feature the work of entrants accurately, there will be no responsibility taken for discrepancy, error, omission or misrepresentation of that entry in any media report. Master Builders Victoria will also be promoting pre, during & post awards, on all of our social media channels.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Supporting documentation is required to accompany your entry; providing judges with information regarding the project prior to inspection.

Your completed entry will comprise of the following components:

A. ONLINE ENTRY

A completed official online entry, including relevant authorisations, must be submitted at: **masterbuildersvic. awardsplatform.com**

B. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

BEST SUSTAINABLE HOME CATEGORY CRITERIA

Contact the Master Builders Victoria Events Team for the criteria and checklist that is required to enter in this category.

C. DIGITAL IMAGES

Images must be taken by a professional photographer. Entrants are responsible for the quality of all images. These images are used in the audiovisual presentation and media; so good quality material will better profile your entry. If providing 'before' shots, please ensure these are clearly identified as 'before' shots.

If entering into the Best Sustainable Home Category, please include images that highlight the sustainable features. Digital images must meet the following specifications:

- Images must reflect the category entered.
- Images must highlight any special features of the project as well as general shots.
- A minimum of eight (8) images (mix of internal and external images). **Please supply landscape format.**
- If entering a renovation/addition category please include two (2) **before** images and clearly identify them as the before images.
- Resolution of 300dpi with an image size of 21cm x 29cm (i.e. equates to A4 in size maximum) in JPEG file type only (no PDF, PPT or TIFF file types).
- No mobile phone images accepted.

If your images are not of high quality you could be asked to resubmit them.

D. PLANS

Max A3 size include elevations/floorplan.

E. ENTRY FEE

\$700 (first entry), \$450 (additional entry), \$110 (kitchen/bathroom)

F. CONTRACT AND PERMITS

Please provide the following:

- Building permit
- Occupancy permit or certificate of final inspection
- Contract Title page including; name of Builder, client information, address of project; and the page that displays contract price, and final statement (signing page)

In the instance that the Builder is entering their own home or that of a next of kin a warranty certificate is a requirement of entry and will need to be supplied.

To support your entry we recommend that you provide additional information including; promotional brochures, client satisfaction letters, media articles or video/time lapse videos.

G. WRITTEN CONFIRMATION

A written confirmation on company letterhead that there were no serious injuries or deaths occurred onsite during construction. A written confirmation on company letterhead that there are no outstanding debts or complaints relating to the project.

BEST DISPLAY HOME

Display homes must be nominated in the price category that reflects the AS DISPLAYED PRICE (not the base price) and must include ALL optional extras as displayed. If entering into a display home category entrant must provide evidence that the property has been open for inspection by the public. This could include advertisements. If a contract is not available to confirm the final price of the Display Home, a breakdown of costings is required.

or multi unit ϑ integrated housing developments, access by judges to a minimum of 2 units is required.

- OVER 12 UNITS

- INTEGRATED HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

BEST KITCHEN

The entrant must identify works not carried out by the entrant. A breakdown of costing specific to the kitchen is required.

- BEST KITCHEN UNDER \$40,000
- BEST KITCHEN IN A DISPLAY HOME
- BEST KITCHEN OVER \$40,000

BEST BATHROOM

The entrant must identify works not carried out by the entrant. A breakdown of costing specific to the bathroom is required.

- BEST KITCHEN UNDER \$30,000
- BEST BATHROOM IN A DISPLAY HOME
- BEST BATHROOM OVER \$30,000

EXCELLENCE IN HEALTH AND SAFETY

This award category judges a nominated project only, which must be inspected whilst under construction. Therefore for this award only, the project must not be completed by the closing date of entries. This category is judged on:

- Communication and consultation
- Safety management systems
- Innovation and higher order control solutions
- Safety culture
- Safety in design

BEST SUSTAINABLE HOME

Open to new homes and renovations entrants are judged on a range of sustainability and energy saving features. This may include features such as the materials used, passive solar design elements, low energy use appliances and renewable energy.

JUDGES' CHOICE AWARDS

Self nomination not applicable for the following categories.

- YOUNG BUILDER OF THE YEAR*
- REGIONAL BUILDER OF THE YEAR**
- MASTER BUILDER OF THE YEAR*

Note: *All entries will automatically be reviewed for these categories. **The Regional Builder of the Year will be awarded from the finalists of the 2024 Master Builders Victoria Regional Building Awards program.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can enter the Master Builders Victoria Building Excellence Awards?

The awards are open to all Master Builders Victoria members within the commercial sector and/or the residential sector of the building industry. To be eligible for entry the project must have been completed within a two year period prior and have reached practical completion by the entry closing date.

Why should I enter?

To gain a competitive edge. Past winners of these awards have gained a valuable self promotion tool. All entrants are showcased in the glossy awards magazine distributed after the presentations. These magazines are distributed to all Master Builders Victoria members. Winners are promoted on the Master Builders Victoria website for 12 months. You receive one complimentary ticket to the Awards Presentation Evening. The awards presentation evening provides the opportunity for you to thank and recognise the hard work of your staff, contractors and to show appreciation to your clients by treating them to a prestigious gala event and night out.

How should I put my entry together?

Members are asked to register via:

masterbuildersvic.awardsplatform.com and follow the step by step process to submit all required information and images. Judging criteria and entry requirements can be viewed once you create your first entry. You can continue to make changes or update your submission until the entry deadline. It really is just simply following the prompts once you have registered. Judges will view your completed submissions online and will conduct an inspection of the entered project.

Can I enter the same project as last year?

No, previous entries may not be resubmitted.

What sort of photos are required to be submitted with my entry and when are they required?

Images of the project must be submitted at the time you submit your entry. Images are to be taken by a professional photographer and should include an assortment of internal and external shots. All images are to be landscape page layout. Images must be 300dpi in resolution in JPEG file type only.

Do you have a photographer you can recommend?

Yes, we work closely with and can recommend a professional photographer. Please phone (03) 9411 4570 to request further information.

What are the photos used for?

The images are used for a variety of purposes: media, newspaper and magazine print but most importantly these images are used within the audiovisual presentation of the awards night. Therefore good quality images will better profile your entry on the night and in various publications if used. Photos of your project are not viewed as part of the judging process.

Are there finalists announced in each category?

No. Master Builders Victoria do not have finalists. All entries are eligible for an award unless previously advised that the entry does not meet the judges criteria.

Are the winners notified before the Awards Presentation Evening?

All winners are announced on the night during the award presentations. No winners are notified prior to this.
