

MANAGING PUBLIC SAFETY – INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP

The Managing Public Safety – Interactive Workshop is for individuals who have a responsibility to plan, manage, maintain and ensure public safety in the workplace. This program will cover the relevant Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Act and Regulations that apply, including practical case studies and real life examples for review. Participants will be engaged in an interactive workshop that includes the delivery of a fully controlled simulated safety exercise.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This half-day workshop will provide participants with a greater awareness of how important managing public safety is. This interactive workshop focuses on the communication and planning required to maintain public safety throughout a project's duration. Participants will be immersed within a simulated safety exercise and be required to actively participate in the initial response and corresponding activities. This simulated safety exercise will be used as a catalyst to encourage active discussion and be the basis for learning designed to increase the participant's knowledge and experience on the subject matter.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

In the Managing Public Safety course participants will:

- Understand the duties of a principal contractor to eliminate public safety risks associated with construction work;
- Understand the importance of and how to effectively engage stakeholders during the planning phase of the project;
- Improve their ability to identify project risk factors, improve compliance and ensure appropriate exclusion zones are incorporated;
- Learn about consequences and corrective actions from real life examples and recent case studies involving public safety;
- Better identify and plan for public asset protection;
- Learn effective methods of collaboration and consultation to improve project communication and safety.

HOW WILL I LEARN?

This workshop is delivered utilising our unique combination of classroom style learning, feedback workshops and a simulated building site. Participants assume a site leadership role and are given the opportunity to practice and apply newly learnt skills and knowledge when confronted with everyday challenges and personalities experienced on site.

Learning is reinforced and enhanced in our simulation sessions with a team of highly trained specialist actors. Participants are given the opportunity to negotiate, problem solve, communicate and provide direction to site personnel, management and subcontractors.

In our safe learning environment, participants will be challenged to demonstrate effective consultation and communication techniques, the opportunity to experience the impact of human error and the ability to engage with key stakeholders as a representative for your organisation.

DEBRIEFING SESSIONS

Each simulation session is monitored by a team of trained observers and is followed by a facilitator led debriefing session. Here participants are able to exchange their experiences and individual feedback is provided by the trained observers.

Through these facilitator led debriefing sessions, participants discover that there are many ways to approach each interaction or challenge and how their actions and responses can influence decisions made relating to public safety. Participants will become aware of their development areas and discover how with practice and refinement these can be improved and implemented back in the workplace.

BLSC participants will develop the skills to effectively reason and problem solve, consult for more effective outcomes and motivate others to think and work more safely for your organisation.
