The Managing Onsite Safety course is designed for site managers, safety representatives and site supervisors who are passionate about driving and influencing a safer working culture. This course focuses on the fundamental skills required to deliver improvements to your company's safety performance. In a highly immersive and interactive learning environment, participants will increase their knowledge of legislated safety responsibilities and accountabilities, ensure adherence to safety standards and demonstrate the quality of supervision required to drive better safety outcomes on site.

HOW WILL I LEARN?

This course is delivered utilising our unique combination of classroom style learning, feedback workshops and a simulated building site. Participants assume a site leadership role and are given the opportunity to practice and apply newly learnt skills and knowledge when confronted with everyday challenges and personalities experienced on site.

Learning is reinforced and enhanced in our simulation sessions with a team of highly trained specialist actors. Participants are given the opportunity to negotiate, problem solve, communicate and provide direction to site personnel, management and subcontractors.

In our safe learning environment, participants will be challenged to demonstrate effective consultation techniques, the ability to inspire others and become the influential leaders of a safety culture for your organisation.

DEBRIEFING SESSIONS

Each simulation is monitored by a team of trained observers and followed by a facilitated debriefing session. Here participants are able to exchange their experiences and individual feedback is provided by the observers.

Participants discover that there are many ways to approach each interaction or challenge and how their actions influence onsite outcomes. Participants will become aware of their development areas having the opportunity to practice, refine and ultimately implement onsite.

BLSC participants will develop the skills to effectively consult and communicate, influence others to maintain standards on their site and ultimately 'spread the safety message' to become better leaders for your organisation.
