

# Construction Induction Training (White Card)

## Course Information Sheet



### About the course

This course is delivered and assessed by The Master Builders Association of Victoria also known as Master Builders Victoria (MBV) - RTO no 3935.

Under WorkSafe Victoria requirements, from 1 July 2008, no person may work on a construction site unless they meet this OHS training requirement or are a current Red/White Card bearer. The course includes the nationally accredited unit of competency CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry which can be used to apply for a White Card to the Victorian safety regulator WorkSafe.

### Learning outcomes

You will have gained the skills and knowledge to:

- Identify health and safety legislative requirements of construction work.
- Identify construction hazards and risk control measures.
- Identify health and safety communication and reporting processes.
- Identify incident and emergency response procedures.

### Who should study this course?

This course is compulsory for:

- Any person employed or engaged to perform construction work in the building and construction industry.

### What you need to bring to class

You must bring.

- The photo ID provided as proof of identity at the point of enrolment.

After successful completion of the course, Master Builders Victoria notifies WorkSafe Victoria which issues the standard Construction Induction Training Card (White Card).
