

Regional Engagement Groups

Terms of Reference

1. INTRODUCTION

Section Committees, which will now be known as Regional Engagement Groups, are constituted under Rule 35 of The Master Builders Association of Victoria (“**MBV**”)’s Rules (“**Rules**”).

There are 4 Regional Engagement Groups namely:

Northern Regional Engagement Group
Southern Regional Engagement Group
Eastern Regional Engagement Group
Western Regional Engagement Group

2. PURPOSE

The role of the MBV’s Regional Engagement Groups is to enable MBV members to meet and discuss local problems, promote social intercommunication between members, and allow Regional Engagement Group members to consider matters of mutual interest.

3. FUNCTION AND ROLE OF REGIONAL ENGAGEMENT GROUPS

Regional Engagement Groups do not have decision-making powers and as such, members of Regional Engagement Groups are not authorised to represent MBV in any capacity. Regional Engagement Groups are simply constructed to provide for interaction between MBV members within their districts.

4. FUNCTION AND ROLE OF MBV TEAM MEMBER ATTENDEES

MBV will nominate a Membership team member to each Regional Engagement Group in order to provide oversight, operational support and coordination to assist with the facilitation of any meetings held for members in the Regional Engagement Groups, with responsibility resting with the Executive, Membership and Communications Director or their appointed delegate.

5. STRUCTURE AND TERM

An MBV member may choose to join any 1 of the 4 Regional Engagement Groups as an ongoing member, on the condition that they hold a current MBV membership that is not suspended, frozen or terminated.

6. MEETING FREQUENCY

As and when required.

7. REVIEW OF TERMS OF REFERENCE

These Terms of Reference will be reviewed at least every two (2) years to ensure that they continue to reflect current processes and guiding principles. The Board of MBV must approve any amendments made to the Terms of Reference as a result of any review.
